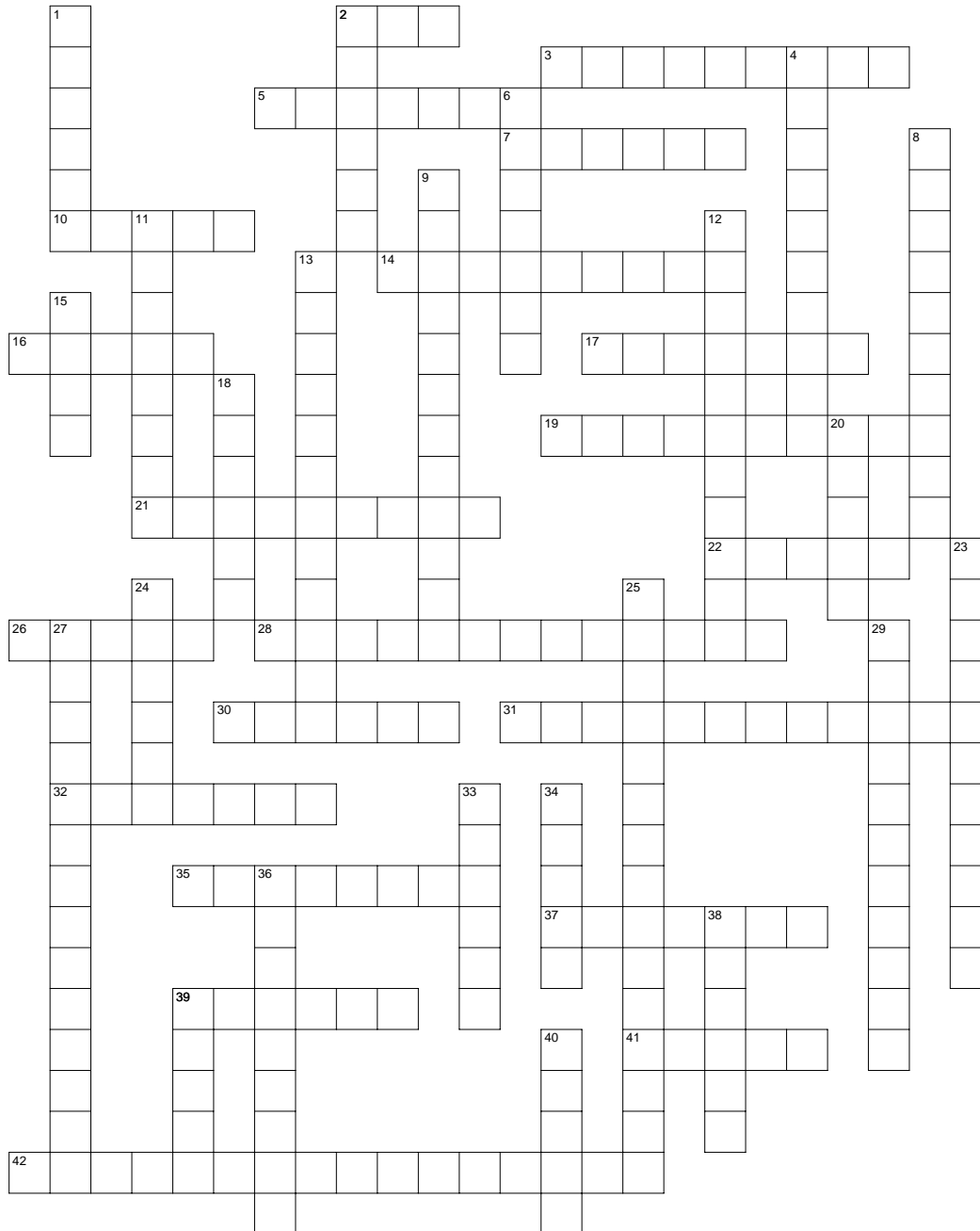

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# Genesis: The Abraham Cycle



## Across

- Abram's nephew and the only innocent man in Sodom.
- God had tightly closed every womb in his household on account of Sarah.
- Pharaoh's house is stricken with these because of Abram's wife.
- The third place where Abram builds an altar to the Lord.
- The desert-like terrain of southern Palestine.
- Usually translated "God the Almighty," but the meaning is uncertain.
- One of 2 cities destroyed by Yahweh because of the sinfulness of its inhabitants.
- Abram's second wife.
- Sarah kneads this much flour for the 3 men who appear outside of Abraham's tent.
- A sacrifice to God, usually a burnt offering.
- "Laughed"
- This nation sees itself as descended from Ishmael.
- Yahweh credits Abram's faith as an act of this.
- The land to which Yahweh sent Lot.
- One of two symbols for the presence of Yahweh when the covenant with Abram is made.
- Abram's first child, but not the one who continues Yahweh's covenant.
- Lot and his older daughter are the parents of the ancestor of these people.
- "The father is exalted."
- Yahweh warns Abram of this future event when the two make their covenant.
- Abram's wife.
- The place from which Yahweh calls Abram.

## Down

- He sells Abraham land for a burial plot for Sarah.
- Lot prepares cakes without this for the 2 messengers of the Lord who visit him.
- A possible natural explanation for what happened to Sodom and Gomorrah.
- The first place Abram builds an altar when passing through Canaan.
- Unique phrase used to describe Isaac in Genesis.
- Lot's wife is turned into one of these when she looks back at Sodom.
- One of 2 cities destroyed by Yahweh because of the sinfulness of its inhabitants.
- The valley of Siddim was full of these.
- What Abraham promised in his covenant with Yahweh.
- The "small town" to which Lot and his family flee.
- "God the Eternal"
- He was 75 years old when he left Haran.
- King of Salem who blesses Abram and shares bread and wine with him.
- One of the 3 men who visits Abraham turns out to be him.
- Abram and Yahweh walk between the split halves of these when they make a covenant.
- One of two symbols for the presence of Yahweh when the covenant with Abram is made.
- The territory that Lot chooses for himself.
- Abram asks his wife to say she is this when the two are traveling.
- The mother of Ishmael.
- Lot and his younger daughter are the parents of the ancestor of these people.
- This name, used for Abram in Gen 14, is otherwise only used by non-Israelites.
- Abram sojourns here because of a famine.
- "Princess"
