

Genesis: The Jacob Cycle



Across

- Jacob's ninth son, the fifth born to Leah.
- Number of tribal groups descended from Ishmael.
- Isaac and Ishmael bury Abraham in a cave here.
- The Israelites did not eat this hip muscle because Jacob was struck there.
- Jacob's "red stuff" is actually this.
- The reference to Laban as this is probably an anachronism.
- Genesis 36 contains a passage that anachronistically refers to this Israelite institution.
- Esau exchanges this in return for some "red stuff" to "gulp down." (NAB)
- Jacob's first daughter, born to Leah.
- Jacob's eighth son, the second born to Zilpah.
- Jacob's third son; founder of the tribe from which all priests must come.
- Jacob's fifth son, the first born of Bilhah.
- His name means "reddish."
- Jacob sees one of these in a dream; often mistranslates as "ladder."
- Because Esau is this, Jacob puts the skin of lambs on his hands to trick Isaac.
- Jacob's tenth son, sixth born to Leah.
- Jacob's name is changed to this; means "I wrestled with God."
- Jacob fools his father into giving this to him instead of Esau.
- Isaac entreated the Lord on behalf of his wife because she was this.
- Jacob worked for Laban for seven more years to marry her.
- Jacob and Laban confront one another here after Jacob flees.
- Jacob's seventh son, the first born of Zilpah.
- Rachel's maidservant; Rachel insists that Jacob have a child through her.
- Jacob's eleventh son, the first one born to Rachel.
- Leah's maidservant, given to Jacob as consort.
- Rebekah's brother; Jacob flees to him when Esau seeks to kill him.
- Jacob sets up one of these when he makes his pact with Laban.

Down

- Rachel steals these from her father.
- While still in pain from this, all the men of Hamor's tribe are killed by Simeon and Levi.
- Son of Hamor the Hivite; he defiles Dinah.
- Rachel hid her father's idols in one of these.
- Means "house of God."
- Isaac goes to Abimilech because of this.
- Jacob was gripping this when he was born.
- Jacob roles a stone away from the mouth of one of these while in Haran.
- Jacob's fourth son.
- Abraham insists that the wife chosen for his son not be this.
- Jacob's sixth son, the second born of Bilhah.
- Esau's descendants.
- Rebekah's father.
- The last son born to Jacob by Rachel before she dies.
- Esau's wives become a source of embitterment to his parents because they are this.
- Jacob does this with a messenger of God.
- The woman chosen to be Isaac's wife.
- This failed Isaac in old age.
- Another name for Esau.
- The name of this town is similar to a Hebrew word for "booths."
- Jacob worked for Laban for seven years to marry her.
- Abraham sends his sons by concubinage to settle here, away from Isaac.
- Means "the face of God."
- Jacob's second-born son.
- Isaac claims that Rebekah is this when they travel through the land of the Philistines.
- After her death, Isaac finds solace in his wife.
- In exchange for some of these, Rachel allows Leah to lie with Jacob for one night.
- Jacob's first-born son.
