In each passage, someone claims that his mission is the fulfillment of prophecy. Who makes the claim, and what prophet do they quote?

4. Luke 5:17-26 || Acts 3:1-10

A miracle is performed in each passage. Who performs it, and who is cured?

5. Luke 5:29-6:11 || Acts 4:1-22, 5:12-42

These passages contain a series of debates. On what subjects?

6. Luke 7:1-10 || Acts 10:1-49

Each of these stories deals with an encounter between Jesus/the apostles and what type of person? What does the person in each story demonstrate that impresses Jesus/the apostles?

7. Luke 7:11-17 || Acts 9:36-43

What is the connection between the miracles performed in these two stories?

8. Luke 19:36-37 || Acts 21:17-20

In both passages, how do people respond to the reports of mighty deeds performed by Jesus/the disciples?

9. Luke 19:45-48 || Acts 21:26

In both passages, just before the beginning of their "passions," where do Jesus and Paul go?

10. Luke 20:27-39 || Acts 23:6-9

In both passages, a dispute breaks out over what belief? In each case, who does the dispute involve?

11. Luke 22:19 || Acts 27:35

State the passage that both stories have in common.

12. Luke 22:54 || Acts 21:30

What happens to Jesus & Paul in these passages?

13. Luke 22:63-64 || Acts 23:2

What happens to Jesus & Paul in these passages?

14. Luke 22:66-23:13 || Acts 23:1-26:32

Who goes on trial in these passages, and in front of whom? How many times does each person go on trial?

15. Luke 23:18 || Acts 21:36

State the passage that both stories have in common.

16. Luke 23:33-46 || Acts 7:54-70
